Hugh Ramsey Nature and World Birding Center:

Volunteers are at the heart of ambitious efforts to replant and beautify Harlingen's wing of the World Birding Center, the World Birding Center at Hugh Ramsey Nature Park. In need of fresh air and sunshine? Join one of the groups who work in Ramsey Park. Come join for Conservation in Action. Contact is Linda Butcher at 956-423-1802 (leave a message). Once you know your assignment, you can schedule the best day for you to volunteer. The goal is to eradicate guinea grass that threatens native plants, trimming trails for the safety of visitors, watering of plants as needed. Hours volunteered under the direction of ACAS are eligible for RGVC Texas Master Naturalists programs.

You can also volunteer to feed the birds (food provided) or conduct guided nature walks.

OTHER OPPORTUNITIES:

ACAS has monthly speakers from Sept thru May, summer and winter educational series, and monthly birding trips. All are welcome. Our programs typically qualify for Advanced Training hours with TMN; there are many volunteer opportunities, for example, on our leadership team for officers such as media admin, secretary, treasurer, etc., festivals and other opportunities for us to teach about education and conservation of our precious habitats.
