Volunteer Opportunities: *There are multiple volunteer opportunities throughout the year from October-June. Field Lessons occur mostly on Fridays but there may be Field Lessons on other days of the week, about 4 times a month.*

These Field Lessons are outdoors so it is recommended that volunteers wear weather appropriate shoes and clothing. Sunblock, sunscreen, hat and long sleeve shirts are recommended depending on the weather.

Field Lessons are geared toward grades 1st-12th grade students and a knowledge of local flora and fauna is helpful.

Types of volunteer opportunities:

1. *Help set up activities.*
2. *Set up tables and chairs.*
3. *Monitor students.*
4. *Distribute lunches and water.*
5. *Optional: Teach/lead an activity.*
6. *Put away tables/chairs/activities/clean up.*
